

1	The rose which represents England, the thistle for Scotland, the daffodil for Wales and the shamrock for Ireland.		
2	The Eagle is illustrated on the ampulla. The eagle is associated with St Thomas Becket, where according to legend the Virgin Mary appeared to Thomas Becket with the golden eagle. Used on the receptacle holding the anointing oil for Kings and Queens, the eagle is used as a messenger from God.		
3	There are three crowns on show, on the left is St Edward's Crown and the right hand side is Imperial State Crown. In the middle is the State Diadem (another type of crown) which the late Queen used to wear on state occasions and which is also seen on the Machin portrait as well as on Queen Victoria's portrait on the Penny Black.		
4	Laurel leaves are illustrated on the stamp, dating back to Roman times the leaves were used to symbolise victory, honour, and peace.		
5	The Sovereign's Sceptre with dove, Sovereign's Sceptre with cross, Sovereign's Orb and Coronation spoon and Ampulla were used at the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II in 1953		
6	King George VI, Queen Elizabeth II and our current monarch, His Majesty King Charles III
